Accordingly, I am requesting that you register my child as a homeschooler, as required by section 13(1) of the BC School Act. I do not wish to utilize an Online Learning Program.

Please note that school boards must ensure that principals, vice principals or directors of instruction register homeschoolers when parents request it (School Act, section 13(2)). If you are unfamiliar with homeschooling registration, the following points may be helpful:

- Homeschoolers are recorded on Form 1701 (see form completion instructions for details).
- Homeschoolers are not required to submit learning plans, report on progress, or have any further contact with their registering school beyond registration.
- Registering schools are required to offer evaluation and assessment services, and the loan of educational resource materials, as described in the School Act, section 13(3) and School Regulation 265/89.
- Homeschoolers may also, with the board's permission, audit educational programs, subject to terms and conditions set by the board, including payment of fees (School Regulation 265/89).
- If a homeschool student wishes to obtain a BC Graduation Certificate (a "Dogwood" diploma), they can enrol in courses for grades 10-12 and complete the required 80 credits like any other student.
